Summary Statement:

Authoring administrative leave for the City Attorney to attend the Alcohol Board meeting on April 6, 2017 to represent the City.

During this upcoming Alcohol Board meeting the Board will be considering three (3) applications for a package store license. If issued, this will be the final package store license available within the City limits for the City of Bethel.

The City Council has not been provided proper opportunity to listen to the citizens of Bethel and make a determination on what position, if any, the council has about the applications. As of the date of the Alcohol Board meeting, it is quite possible that none of the applicants will have fully completed the conditional use permit application process.

Additionally, because the AMCO board failed to properly notify the City, one application being considered will be reviewed <u>before</u> the City deadline for review. Thus, a decision could be made prior to the City's having a proper opportunity to hear from its citizens and to consider the matter.

As the City has learned from the past, telephonic participation is not as well heard as in person. Having a person there to represent the City and ensure the City is represented goes much further with the Board and goes a long way towards ensuring anyone on the phone is given more weight.
