ORDINANCE #00-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ADOPTED ANNUAL FY 1999-2000 BUDGET

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that the FY 1999-2000 Annual Budget be amended as follows:
