ORDINANCE #05-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.12.050 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE CITY ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, AS 29.20.360 provides that the City Attorney is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the chief administrator of a municipality unless otherwise provided by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the chief administrator for the City of Bethel is the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to have the City Attorney be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the City Council;

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.


SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 2.12.050 of the Bethel Municipal Code entitled "City attorney" is hereby amended to read as follows (old language is stricken out and new language is underlined):

2.12.050 City attorney.

The city attorney is the legal advisor of the council and other ~~officers~~ officials of the municipality. He ~~The city attorney~~ shall represent the city in civil and criminal proceedings. Notwithstanding AS 29.20.360, the city attorney shall be appointed by, and serve at the pleasure of, the city council.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the City Council.
