AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE 07-08 FOR THE PLANNING, CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF A MULTIUSE RECREATION CENTER

WHEREAS the Bethel City Council has passed Ordinance #07-08 which calls for a budgetary allotment for the planning, construction, operation and maintenance of a multiuse recreation center;

WHEREAS the effective date of Ordinance #07-08 was upon passage by the citizens of Bethel of a two year, 1% sales tax increase in the October 2007 general election;

WHEREAS certain grant funds may be available to help defray the costs associated with planning, construction, operation and maintenance of a multiuse recreation center;

WHEREAS the recreation center project would be more attractive to grant funding agencies with a longer tax commitment from the city of Bethel;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and shall not be codified within the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage of a 1% sales tax increase for 2 yrs for planning, construction, operation & costs and a .5% sales tax increase for the next 18 yrs for operation & maintenance costs in the October, 2007 General Election.

ENACTED THIS 22^{nd} DAY OF MAY 2007, BY A VOTE OF <u>4</u> IN EAVOR AND <u>1</u> OPPOSED.
