### **ORDINANCE #09-25**

#### **AN ORDINANCE BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE FUNDING OF THE DESIGNATED BATH CENTER ACCOUNT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel ("City") levies a sales tax, of which a percentage is intended to fund development of the Bethel Aquatic Training and Health (BATH) Center;

**WHEREAS**, the City has established in Ordinance 07-08 that no more than \$1,050,000 shall be held in a designated account;

**WHEREAS**, it is imperative that funds designated for the BATH Center account not be co-mingled with other funding to ensure availability;

**WHEREAS**, a designated interest bearing account specifically for the BATH Center has already been established;

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska; that:


**Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall not be codified in the Bethel Municipal Code.

**SECTION 2. Amendment.** The Designation of Annual Budgetary Allotment in Ordinance 07-08 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken out):


F. Funds generated from sales tax revenue that are designated for the BATH Center will be appropriated on a monthly basis to the designated interest bearing BATH Center account.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective no sooner than 60 days and no later than 90 days, after passage of said ordinance.
