## ORDINANCE #209

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REPEALING ORDINANCES 8, 97, 137, 148, 166 AND THE CORRESPONDING TITLE 14 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE AND ESTABLISHING A NEW TITLE 14, ENTITLED CITY OF BETHEL PORT ORDINANCE.

Section 1: Ordinance 8, 97, 137, 148, 166 and the corresponding Title 14 of the Bethel Municipal Code are repealed.

Section 2: This ordinance shall not be construed as abating any action now pending under, or by virtue of, prior existing laws, or as discontinuing, abating, modifying or altering any penalty accruing or about to accrue, or as affecting the liability of any person, or as waiving any right of the City under any section or provision existing at the time this ordinance is adopted, or as vacating or annulling any right obtained by any person, firm or corporation, by lawful action of the City except as shall be expressly provided for in this Title.

Section 3: If any part or provision of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision, or application directly involved in all controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered, and shall not affect or impair the invalidity of the remainder of this Title or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances. The City Council hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance even without any such part, provision or application.

<u>Section 4</u>: The City of Bethel Port Ordinance, as enacted by this ordinance, shall take effect on the date this ordinance is adopted.

<u>Section 5</u>: Title 14 of the Bethel Municipal Code of Ordinances entitled City of Bethel Port Ordinance in the form attached hereto is hereby adopted.

**Section 6**: This ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
