### Ordinance 21-26 (h) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF BETHEL FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET

**THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, as follows:

**SECTION 1. Classification.** This is a non-codified Ordinance and shall not become part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

**SECTION 2. Fiscal Year Budget Amendments.** The following estimated revenues and expenditures are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of the City of Bethel for Fiscal Year 2022.


**WHEREAS**, Public Works Department, Streets and Roads division budget line item 10-66-601, Vehicle Maintenance is overexpent by \$3,490.30;

**WHEREAS**, with the prediction of additional maintenance parts being required, Public Works is requesting \$40,000 to be allocated from the general fund;


