## AN ORDINANCE BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE CITY OF BETHEL **OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 BEGINNING JULY 1, 2023, ENDING JUNE 30, 2024**

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA:

**Section 1. Classification**. This is a non-codified Ordinance establishing the City of Bethel Annual Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2024. The document entitled "Annual Budget for the City of Bethel, Alaska July 1, 2023-June 30, 2024, which is available for examination by the public in the Finance Department, the City's website and is incorporated herein by reference is hereby adopted as the budget for the City of Bethel for fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.

**Section 2.** The following sums of money are hereby appropriated for the operations of the City of Bethel for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of July 1, 2023, and ending the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2024, to be expended consistent with and subject to the restrictions, procedures, and purposes set forth in the Code of the City of Bethel, and to be expended substantially by line item in the manner shown in the budget adopted by Section 1 hereof:
