ORDINANCE #94-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2.04.030 ENTITLED ORDER OF BUSINESS OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE BY MOVING PEOPLE TO BE HEARD IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING ROLL CALL ON THE CITY COUNCIL AGENDA.

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council developed Council Policies and Procedures which will include meeting protocol, parliamentary guidelines and Council job responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the policies and procedures provide for a change to the Council agenda which would move People to be Heard to the beginning of the agenda; and

WHEREAS, Council conducted a 90-day trial period to determine if the change to the agenda was of benefit to both Council and the public; and

WHEREAS, it is required that an ordinance be passed and approved to effect a permanent change in the order in which the City Council conducts business;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Title 2 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended by revising Chapter 2.040.03.

Section 2: If any part or provision of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision, or application directly involved in all controversy in which this judgment shall have been rendered, and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this title or application thereof to other persons or circumstances. The City Council hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance even without such part, provision, or application.

Section 3: Ordinance #94-11 amending Title 2, Chapter 2.04.030 of the Bethel Municipal Code of Ordinances is hereby adopted as follows:

2.040.030 Order of business. Business shall be conducted in the following manner:

Call to Order
Roll Call

People to be Heard -- Limited to three (3) minutes

- a. Agenda Items Not Scheduled for Public Hearing
- b. Items Other Than Those Appearing on the Agenda

Approval of Minutes

Approval of Agenda and Consent Agenda

- a. Approval of Consent Agenda passes all routine items indicated by an asterisk on the agenda.


