ORDINANCE # 96-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL AMENDING SECTION 5.20.060 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE BY REPEALING SUBSECTION G, WHICH PROVIDES FOR REVOCATION OF A TRANSPORTATION PERMIT OR CHAUFFEURS LICENSE, FOR FIVE YEARS UPON THE ISSUANCE OF A FOURTH VIOLATION WITHIN FOUR YEARS OF THE DATE OF THE FIRST VIOLATION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification: This is a code ordinance.

Section 2. Content: Section 5.20.060 of the Bethel Municipal Code is hereby amended by repealing subsection G:

G. After a hearing, the Transportation Inspector shall revoke a bus permit, dispatch service permit, river taxi permit, taxicab permit, or chauffeur's license, for five years upon a fourth violation of Chapter 5.20, 5.30, 5.40, or 5.50, or municipal regulation promulgated under such Chapters if said fourth violation occurred within four years of the date of the first violation.

Section 3. Savings Clause: This ordinance shall not be construed as abating any action now pending under, or by virtue of, prior existing laws or as discontinuing, abating, modifying, or altering any penalty accruing or about to accrue, or as affecting the liability of any person, or as waiving any right of the City under any section or provision existing at the time this ordinance is adopted, or as vacating or annulling any right obtained by any person, firm, or corporations, by lawful action of the City except as shall be expressly provided for in this title.

Section 4. Severability: If any part or provision of the ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confirmed in its operation to the part, provision, or application directly involved in all controversy in which this judgment shall have been rendered, and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this title or application thereof to other persons or circumstances. The City Council hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance even without such part, provision, or application.
