## **ORDINANCE # 96-17**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL AMENDING TITLE 2.28 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLED "TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL:

Section 1. Classification. This is a code ordinance.

Section 2. Severability. If any part or provision of the ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision, or application directly involved in the controversy in which this judgment shall have been rendered, and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or application thereof to other persons or circumstances. The City Council hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance even without such part, provision, or application.

Section 3. <u>Content</u>: Section 2.28.010 of the Bethel Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding new subsections E and F, as follows:

- E Vacancies The Commission shall keep attendance records and notify the Mayor when vacancies occur. A vacancy shall be declared and filled when the member:
  - 1. Fails to qualify and take office within thirty days after appointment by the mayor of confirmation by the council;
  - 2. Plans to depart from the city for more than ninety (90) days and is unable to attend meetings;
    - 3 Resigns from service on the commission;
    - 4. Misses three unexcused consecutive regular meetings;
  - 5. Is convicted of a felony or an offense involving a violation of the Transportation Commission Oath of Office.
- F. No more than two people may be seated on the Transportation Commission who have a financial interest in the vehicle for hire industry. Any person that applies for a seat on the Transportation Commission shall disclose any financial interest they have in the vehicle for hire industry at the time of application for a position on the Commission.
