ORDINANCE # 96-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL AMENDING TITLE 2.04.110 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLED "APPOINTIVE OFFICERS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL:

Section 1. Classification. This is a code ordinance.

Section 2. Severability. If any part or provision of the ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision, or application directly involved in the controversy in which this judgment shall have been rendered, and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or application thereof to other persons or circumstances. The City Council hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance even without such part, provision, or application.


Section 3. Content: Section 2.04.110(A) of the Bethel Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows (new text is underlined, deleted text is overstruck):

2.04.110 Appointive officers.


A. The council by majority consent shall appoint a city attorney, city clerk, and a city manager ~~and a city police chief~~ and shall ratify such other appointments as they see fit. The council shall instruct them as to their duties and all the laws, regulations and procedures surrounding the office.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
