ORDINANCE #96-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL AMENDING TITLE 4.20.060, "PURCHASING AGENT--OFFICE ESTABLISHED--APPOINTMENT--TERM", AND TITLE 4.20.070, "POWERS AND DUTIES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL:

Section 1. Classification This is a code ordinance.

Section 2. Severability If any part or provision of the ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision, or application directly involved in the controversy in which this judgment shall have been rendered, and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or application thereof to other persons or circumstances. The City Council hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance even without such part, provision, or application.

Section 3. Amendment of Section 4.20.060 Section 4.20.060 (B) and (C) of the Bethel Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows (deleted text is overstruck, new text is underlined):

4.20.060 Purchasing Agent--Office established--Appointment--Term.

B. Appointment. The purchasing agent shall be appointed by the ~~finance director~~ City Manager. The purchasing agent shall ~~have a minimum of two years experience in public purchasing within five years preceding the date of appointment~~ possess such knowledge and skills as are listed in the job description for that position.

C. Tenure. The purchasing agent shall be appointed to serve an indefinite term and may be removed from office by the ~~finance director~~ City Manager in accordance with city personnel regulations. (Ord. 163 §2-101, 1985)

Section 4. Amendment of Section 4.20.070. Section 4.20.070 (B) of the Bethel Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows (deleted text is overstruck, new text is underlined):

4.20.070 Purchasing Agent--Powers and duties.


B. Duties. In accordance with this chapter, and subject to the supervision of the ~~finance director~~ City Manager, the purchasing agent shall.

1. Procure or supervise the procurement of all supplies and services needed by the city;
2. Sell, trade, or otherwise dispose of surplus supplies and fixed assets belonging to the city.
