ORDINANCE NO. 97-09

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SAND FOR USE IN GOVERNMENT PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the City owns a sand pit for which the owner of the subsurface estate has conveyed to the City all sand rights; and

WHEREAS, the City's sand should be made available for use in government projects.

THEREFORE, **BE IT ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Bethel:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Chapter. Chapter 4.,10 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended by adding a new section 4.20.050 reading:

4.20.196 Sale of sand. Sand from the City Sand Pit may be sold by the city for use on projects owned and built or being built by or for a governmental entity. Such sales may be made directly to the governmental entity or to the contractor, or a subcontractor, having a contract with the governmental entity for the construction of the project in which the sand will be used. The manager shall establish and may periodically adjust the price for sand which shall be effective for sales of sand thereafter. The price shall be a fair price as determined by the manager after consideration of the price paid for sand from other pits in Bethel. The manager may establish such rules as may be needed to govern the operations within the pit, the measurement of the sand, purchasing and payment, and other matters affecting the sale, excavation, hauling and use of the sand. The price and rules established by the manager may be changed by the council by resolution.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon adoption.
