ORDINANCE #97-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL AMENDING TITLE 5 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE, RESTRICTING THE NUMBER OF HOURS A CHAUFFEUR MAY DRIVE IN ONE DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Section. Bethel Municipal Code Chapter 5.40 is amended by adding a new Section 100 reading:

5.40.100 Limitations on Driving Time.

For purposes of this section "shift" means a consecutive period of time a chauffeur is available for dispatch; a shift begins at the earlier of the time the chauffeur is available for dispatch or is actually dispatched and ends when the chauffeur is no longer available for dispatch. A shift includes breaks and rest periods. A chauffeur may not work a shift that exceeds 12 hours. A chauffeur may not begin a shift within 10 hours of the time the preceding shift ended.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
