BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Amendment to Section. BMC Section 13.16.020(C) shall be amended to read:

SECTION 6. Amendment to Section. BMC Section 13.16.070 is amended to read:

13.16.070 Senior citizen credit.

- A. Any Bethel citizen at least sixty-five years of age residing in their own household shall receive up to a fifty-dollar [TWENTY-FIVE-DOLLAR] monthly utility credit, if they are the primary source of income, after making application for such at the city utilities office.
- B. Any Bethel citizen at least sixty years of age by June 30, 1999, residing in their own household shall receive up to a twenty-five-dollar monthly utility credit, if they are the primary source of income, after making application for such at the city utility office.

[ALL OTHER BETHEL CITIZENS AT LEAST SIXTY YEARS OF AGE THAT DO NOT MEET THE CONDITIONS OF SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION SHALL RECEIVE UP TO A TEN-DOLLAR MONTHLY UTILITY CREDIT AFTER MAKING APPLICATION FOR SUCH TO THE CITY UTILITIES OFFICE.]

B. Each residential unit shall be limited to one credit application.

SECTION 6. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1999.
