ORDINANCE #99-05

A ORDINANCE AMENDING PIPED RATES AND SENIOR CITIZEN CREDIT FOR WATER AND SEWER AND ESTABLISHING RATES FOR KASAYULIE SUBDIVISION

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Amendment to Section. BMC Section 13.16.020(C) shall be amended to read:

C. Residential/commercial piped water rates:

1. Residential Service:

Frequency of Service

Monthly flat rate (non-metered)

Rate

\$76.00 [57.50] per month

2. Commercial Service:

Frequency of Service

Monthly rate (metered service)

Monthly rate (non-metered service)

Rate

\$11.50 per 1000 gallons

\$76.00 [57.50] per month per dwelling unit

SECTION 3. Amendment to Section. BMC Section 13.16.020 is amended by adding a new subsection reading:

E. Service to Kasaylie Subdivision. All water service to Kasaylie Subdivision will be billed at 33% higher than rate stated herein.

SECTION 4. Amendment to Section. BMC Section 13.16.030(C)(1) is amended to read:

C. Piped Sewer Service:

1. Flat rate (non-metered service):

Frequency of Service

Monthly Rate

Rate

\$24.00 [18.00] per month per dwelling unit

SECTION 5. Amendment to Section. BMC Section 13.16.030 is amended by adding a new subsection reading:

F. Service to Kasaylie Subdivision. All sewer service to Kasaylie Subdivision will be billed

at 33% higher than rate stated herein.

SECTION 6. Amendment to Section. BMC Section 13.16.070 is amended to read:

13.16.070 Senior citizen credit.

A. Any Bethel citizen at least sixty-five years of age residing in their own household shall receive up to a fifty-dollar [TWENTY-FIVE-DOLLAR] monthly utility credit, if they are the primary source of income, after making application for such at the city utilities office.

B. Any Bethel citizen at least sixty years of age by June 30, 1999, residing in their own household shall receive up to a twenty-five-dollar monthly utility credit, if they are the primary source of income, after making application for such at the city utility office.

[ALL OTHER BETHEL CITIZENS AT LEAST SIXTY YEARS OF AGE THAT DO NOT MEET THE CONDITIONS OF SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION SHALL RECEIVE UP TO A TEN-DOLLAR MONTHLY UTILITY CREDIT AFTER MAKING APPLICATION FOR SUCH TO THE CITY UTILITIES OFFICE.]

B. Each residential unit shall be limited to one credit application.

SECTION 6. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1999.
