ORDINANCE #99-25

A ORDINANCE AMENDING BMC 2.52.040, RELATING TO CITY EMPLOYEES SERVING ON COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS AND BOARDS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Amendment of Section: Bethel Municipal Code Section 2.52.040 is amended to read as follows:

2.52.040 Qualifications.

In addition to any other qualifications required by this code, a member:

- A. shall have been a resident of the city for one year; and
- B. shall remain a resident of the city while in office.

C. Except as provided in section 2.52.170, a city employee shall not be appointed to a committee, commission or board which conducts any business that concerns or relates to the department where the employee works. A city employee may, however, be appointed to a committee, commission or board which conducts business that concerns or relates to another city department.


SECTION 3. Effective date. This ordinance becomes effective upon enactment.
