RESOLUTION # 11

WHEREAS the Council has not heretofore selected and established a fiscal year for the City of Bethel, and

WHEREAS the need for establishing a fiscal year became apparent during the recent audit of the City books, and

WHEREAS most Government agencies have selected the period of July 1st until June 30st of the next year as fiscal period, and

WHEREAS it would appear that to conform to this practice would be in the interest of and facilitating proper record-keeping for the City,

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED:

that the fiscal year of the City of Bethel will run from July 1st of any year until June 30th of the following year,

that the yearly audit be based on this period,

that for the purpose of the take-over from one Council to the next, the cash balance claimed to be on hand be verified by the City auditor and that the succeeding Council begin the management of finances upon receipt of the auditor's statement.
