

RESOLUTION NO.117

WATER AND WASTE DISPOSAL SYSTEM LOAN PRE-APPLICATION

- WHEREAS, the City of Bethel currently desires to expand and improve its water supply and sewage collection service; and
- WHEREAS, expansion and improvement of the City of Bethel water supply and sewage collection service is currently necessary and desirable to conform with the requirements of the National Environmental Protection Act; and
- WHEREAS, neither cash or credit is currently available for the construction of expanded and improved water supply and sewage collection services; and
- WHEREAS, either cash or credit for the construction of improved or expanded water supply and sewage collection services before the planning of such services or related facilities is justified; and
- Whereas, the Farmers Home Administration of the U.S. Department of Agriculture has a loan program for rural communities to assist with the financing of the construction of necessary and desirable water supply and sewage collection facilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Bethel apply to the Farmers Home Administration for a loan in the amount of \$200,000, under the authority of the Rural Development Act of 1972, to be used for the purpose of financing the expansion and improvement of the City of Bethel water supply and sewage collection facilities and services.
