RESOLUTION NO. 12

OF THE FOURTH CLASS CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA

WHEREAS, the City Council in its meeting of May 21st, 1962 unanimously agreed that they feel it is unusual practice which does not lead to increased respect for the law to allow prisoners time to produce fines after sentencing. Though this presumably is done in the interest of jail economy we feel it is false economy.

In addition we feel that it is probably false economy to let prisoners work without full time supervision.

WHEREAS, we feel that to put sharper teeth in the law will be more economical in the long run,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, we request a copy of this resolution be sent to the Deputy Magistrate so that that office may know the opinion and desires of the Council.

Passed and adopted by the members of the Bethel City Council by a vote of 5 ayes and 0 nays.
