CITY OF BETHEL RESOLUTION # 132

WHEREAS the Brown Slough project was contingent on the ability of the City in securing the necessary right of ways for construction and

WHEREAS all of the land holders did not desire to sell their lands and

WHEREAS the City Council of Bethel then exercised its prerogative of initiating an ordinance which by State Statutes in cases of Second Class Cities must be ratified by the qualified voters of the City and

WHEREAS this election was conducted on the 19 of March 1974 and

WHEREAS the right of taking or Eminent Domain was defeated by the voters

NOW THEREFORE let it be resolved that the Brown Slough Project be terminated as such and

LET IT BE FURTHER resolved that the State of Alaska, the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers and the City of Bethel direct its efforts in building a small boat harbor in the meadow behind louse town which is approachable by water through the louse town slough and

FURTHER let it be resolved that as much as there will be no cost for lands in the louse town slough boat harbor that the State release to the City those monies presently reserved by the State for acquisition of properties in the Brown Slough Area.
