## RESOLUTION NO. 15

### OF THE FOURTH CLASS CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA:

WHEREAS it is necessary through City Council action to pass resolutions for the condemnation of buildings and property within the incorporated limits of the City of Bethel, Alaska that are not habitable and present a danger to life and property of its citizens; and

WHEREAS the house owned by Mr. Mitchell Kossakowski, 4345 South Paulina St., Chicago 9, Illinois and which is located approximately 100 feet directly behind the old Alaska Airlines Building and adjacent to the warehouses of Snow Transportation Co. and the Northern Commercial Co. has been gutted by fire, is used by children for play purposes and is a potential hazard to life and personal injury as well as a further fire hazard; and

WHEREAS the removal of this building will eliminate the hazards present

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska that the owner of the building in question, Mr. Mitchell Kossakowski, be advised that the building must be razed and all materials therefrom be removed from the property thereof; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska that unless this building is removed within sixty days from the date of this resolution that the City of Bethel will take whatever measures necessary to have the building torn down and removed at no cost to the City of Bethel and with any costs involved charged to Mr. Mitchell Kossakowski.

Passed and adopted by the members of the City Council of Bethel by a vote of 5 ayes and 0 nays.
