WHEREAS, the Bethel airport is in need of improvements to increase the efficiency and safety for aircraft and airport operations and maintenance;

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is committed to work closely with the City of Bethel to plan and design the airport improvement project;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel, City Council supports the State of Alaska's efforts to implement improvements at the Bethel Airport that do not disturb or access the City's Cemetery, Alaska Territorial Guard Park or the Communities Rifle Range all located as a "potential materials site" on the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities Bethel Airport Improvements Area of Potential Effects map dated 7-28-2016;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel will only support the State of Alaska Department of Transportation improvements if the project complies in the City's Bethel Municipal Code 12.05, Complete Streets.




