A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE FEDERAL DISASTER ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATION ARRANGE TO HAVE AN APPROPRIATE FEDERAL AGENCY PROVIDE FOR THE NECESSARY DESIGN AND RESTORATION OF THE BETHEL HEIGHTS WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of December, 1975, the President declared a "major disaster" in the State of Alaska under the provisions of Public Law 288, 93rd Congress, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is a public entity within said State and

WHEREAS, it is beyond the financial and administrative capabilities of the City of Bethel to adequately administer a multi-million dollar design and construction contract.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Resolved, by the City Council of Bethel that the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration be and hereby is requested to arrange to have the appropriate Federal Agency provide for the necessary design and restoration of the Bethel Heights water and sewer systems which were extensively damaged as the result of the declared major disaster. The necessary design phase of the Bethel Heights water and sewer systems shall be presented by the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration to the City Council of Bethel for review and approval prior to the implementation of the restoration phase of the aforementioned water and sewer systems.

This body certifies that, to the best of its knowledge and belief, the requested work is eligible under Public Law 288, 93rd Congress, and agrees to (a) provide without cost to the United States all lands, easements, and rights-of-way necessary to accomplishment of the approved work; and (b) hold and save the United States free from damages due to the approved work and indemnify the Federal Government against any claim arising from such work.
