

RESOLUTION NO. 196

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, PROVIDING FOR THE FUTURE DISPOSITION OF MUNICIPALLY-OWNED REAL PROPERTY DESIGNATED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A SMALL BOAT HARBOR.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel in FY 1972 received and expended a monetary grant allocation from the State of Alaska, Public Works Department, Division of Water and Harbors to acquire land, within the Municipality's jurisdictional boundaries and adjacent to the Brown Slough area, for the purpose of constructing a small boat harbor;

WHEREAS, the Municipality was unable to acquire all land necessary to properly construct an adequate small boat harbor during the same and subsequent fiscal years;

WHEREAS, the need for a small boat harbor still exists as evidenced by the inordinate use of the Brown Slough area by citizens of Bethel who own and/or operate watercraft; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel remains interested in constructing a small boat harbor in the future at the Brown Slough area site location;

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Bethel hereby declares that all land purchased for the purpose of developing a small boat harbor adjacent to the Brown Slough area shall be held in public trust by the City until utilized at a later date for the aforesaid purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such land purchased with State funds will not be sold or otherwise disposed of for other purposes inconsistent with the establishment and operation of a public small boat harbor unless otherwise provided for by the State of Alaska and the City of Bethel under mutual agreement.


