

RESOLUTION NO. 197

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA APPOINTING, FROM THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE MUNICIPALITY, JUDGES OF ELECTION IN PRECINCTS NUMBER ONE AND TWO.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 96 of the Municipality, passed and approved by City Council on the 21st of April, 1977, provides for the submission to the qualified voters in Bethel, Alaska, the proposition question of issuance of \$795,000.00 of general obligation bonds of the City of Bethel to pay the costs of planning, designing, constructing, and equipping the Bethel Court Building, at the Special Election to be held for that purpose in Bethel on May 17, 1977;

WHEREAS, a Notice of Special Election and Bonded Indebtedness has been posted in the City of Bethel on the 22nd of April, 1977, and published in newspapers of general circulation within the Municipality's jurisdictional boundaries in accordance with statutory and ordinance requirements;

WHEREAS, the duty of the City Council, pursuant to Section 2.44.100 of Chapter 2.44 (Elections) of the Bethel Code of Ordinances, is to appoint, from the qualified electors of the City of Bethel, at least three (3) but not more than five (5) judges of election in each precinct, at a regular or special meeting held at least seven (7) days previous to the date of holding the election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is required by the aforesaid Section of the Bethel Code of Ordinances to designate one judge in each precinct as a chairperson of the judges appointed and to constitute all judges selected as the Board of Election for the Special Election to be held on May 17, 1977, in Bethel, Alaska.

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the City Council of the Municipality of Bethel hereby appoints, from the qualified electors of the City of Bethel, the following judges of election in each precinct within the Municipality's jurisdictional boundaries, two of whom are designated as chairpersons, and all appointees shall constitute the Board of Election for the Special Election to be held on May 17, 1977, in Bethel, Alaska:


