RESOLUTION NO. 211

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL GRANTING A UTILITY EASEMENT TO BETHEL UTILITIES COMPANY ALONG THE PLATTED ROADWAYS OF THE CITY OF BETHEL FOR THE PURPOSE OF UTILITY POLE LOCATION.

WHEREAS, electrical power poles are a necessity in order to provide power to the residents of the City of Bethel, and

WHEREAS, the location of these power poles must be placed in such a manner as to provide easy emergency access and not intrude upon private property, and


WHEREAS, those official surveys for the City of Bethel showing property lines, roadways, etc., do not provide for utility easements, but do provide for adequate to large sized roadways, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation has granted a similar easement to Bethel Utilities Company along the State highway located in Bethel,


NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the City of Bethel hereby grants a utility easement to the Bethel Utilities Company along the platted roadways within the City of Bethel for the purpose of utility pole location. Be it further understood that Bethel Utilities Company shall be responsible for surveying property lines and exact locations of the roadways at no cost to the City. Power poles shall be located immediately adjacent to property lines where feasible and in between individual property dividing lines so as not to obscure access to and from resident property and not to obstruct traffic patterns.
