RESOLUTION NO. 212

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL ENDORSING WIEN AIR ALASKA'S REQUEST TO EXTEND ITS ALASKA SERVICES INTO THE LOWER FORTY-EIGHT STATES BY THE ADDITION OF A FLIGHT BETWEEN ANCHORAGE AND SEATTLE.

WHEREAS, Wien Air Alaska has applied for additional authority to provide services between Anchorage and Seattle, and

WHEREAS, Wien Air Alaska intends to provide the service at a reduced rate to the flying public, and

WHEREAS, the Lower Yukon Kuskokwim residents are transported between Bethel and Anchorage via Wien Air Alaska and that an additional Anchorage/Seattle flight authority given to Wien Air Alaska would be advantageous to the area, both in convenience and in cost when continuing on to Seattle,

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Bethel does hereby endorse Wien Air Alaska's request to extend its service into the lower forty-eight states by the addition of a flight between Anchorage and Seattle.
