WHEREAS, the inclusion of fire safety inspections in the Municipality may deter a major disaster, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Fire Marshall's Office, will support the local enforcement of the Fire Code by assisting with Fire and Life Safety Surveys, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Fire Marshall's, office will provide assistance in the execution of compliance against violators of the Alaska Fire Safety Code, and


WHEREAS, the City of Bethel's, Fire Department agrees to effectively carry out the enforcement of Fire Safety Code to the best of their ability, and

WHEREAS, the Bethel Fire Department agrees to (implement) an on-going educational program on the enforcement of the Alaska Fire Safety Code.


