WHEREAS, there currently exists in Bethel a District Recorder in the District Recorders Office for the purpose of recording and filing land transaction documents, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Administration is considering abolishing the District Recorder position in Bethel whereby recording would be completed by mail to the main recording office in Anchorage only, and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act has been inacted and will stimulate land transactions in this region and


WHEREAS, the Bethel service district for the District Recorder encompasses an area with over 50 villages, and

WHEREAS, personalized assistance and knowledge of local affairs is invaluable to the residents of this city and region.
