RESOLUTION #249

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, THE ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY AND ALLOCATE FUNDS TO BEGIN WITH THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Southwestern Alaska are confronted with the need for dredging jobs; and

WHEREAS, the dredging rig has been transported to another location by the people who administer the machine without recognizing regional needs; and

WHEREAS, the result of dredging in specific areas will enhance the public economically, socially and in safety; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bethel would like to see the dredging of Napakiak slough because of the need to conserve energy, the need to evade the tremendous waves at the mouth of Johnson River, and the need to pass by without having to loose too much time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that, the Army Corp of Engineers conduct a feasibility study and allocate funds to begin with the project.
