RESOLUTION NO. 268

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF HUGHES, THORSNESS, GANTZ, POWELL & BRUNDIN AS BOND COUNSEL FOR THE PROPOSED SALE OF SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$600,000.00) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF BETHEL.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bethel proposes to submit to the qualified voters of the City by ordinance the question of the issuance of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) of general obligation bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the firm of Hughes, Thorsness, Gantz, Powell & Brundin be, and it hereby is, appointed bond counsel for the City of Bethel, Alaska, to perform the duties of bond counsel in connection with the proposed sale of said Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) of general obligation bonds.
