

RESOLUTION #272

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL SUPPORTING THE OVERWHELMING NEED TO CONSTRUCT A FIRE STATION AND AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY COUNCIL IN APPLYING FOR HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT FUNDS FOR THIS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, by and through the Bethel City Council and the Bethel Planning Commission, citizens of Bethel have provided valuable input into the needs and long term goals for the city; and;


WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council recognizing the overwhelming need for a fire station, at a public hearing designated the fire station as its number one construction priority; and;

WHEREAS, the citizens of Bethel at the October 2nd election voted 10 to 1 in support of the fire station.

NOWHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Council hereby directs the City's Administration to submit on behalf of the Citizens of Bethel a preliminary application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development, Small Cities Program, and;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Bethel that a fire station is an overwhelming need as stated by the citizens of Bethel, and hereby authorizes the City Administration to act on behalf of the City Council in applying for and administering Housing and Urban Development funds.
