RESOLUTION NO. 273

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, AKASKA REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION TO GRANT ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL'S EXPANSION OF THE SEWAGE LAGOON.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has already granted the City funds to expand the existing sewage lagoon, and


WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has designed the expansion and solicited bids to increase the capacity of the lagoon, and the available funds will not cover the completion of the project, and

WHEREAS, there exists funds for the above described project are available from the "1978 Water Supply and Sewage Systems Fund" from the Department of Environmental mental Conservation in accordance with the Village Safe Water Act.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska that we request the State of Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation to grant the City of Bethel for an additional \$266,000 for the expansion of the Municipal Sewage Lagoon and that the City Manager of his designee is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as is necessary to carry out this resolution adopted herein.
