RESOLUTION NO. 276

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL REQUESTING GRANT IN AID CONSTRUCTION FUNDS FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWER PROJECT TO CONNECT BETHEL KILBUCK SCHOOL AND THE BNC OFFICE COMPLEX TO THE EXISTING SEWAGE LINE AND AUTHORIZING CITY ADMINISTRATION TO CARRY OUT ALL NECESSARY FUNCTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT.

WHEREAS, the proposed system shall promote an efficient sewage system and shall reduce the potential for a health hazard as compared to the present system utilized at the Kilbuck School; and

WHEREAS, BNC is presently constructing an office complex which can tie into this sewage system, and


WHEREAS, if this system is not constructed, the treated affluent shall be pumped into Dull Lake by BNC and a lake in the flood plain by the school.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the City Administration is directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain an Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation Construction In Aid Grant for partial funding of the design and construction of a sewer line which will service the Kilbuck School, National Guard Armory, BNC Office Complex, and the potential of servicing other units along the sewage line route.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council, as Council's authorized representative in accepting and implementing the grant award if funded.
