RESOLUTION NO. 278

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION AND THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO DEVELOP A COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bethel is the duly elected governmental authority responsible for fiscal and policy matters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel and the entire Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta face increased impacts due to proposed oil and gas exploration; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has a newly enacted Coastal Zone Management Act that can help communities plan for the use of Coastal Areas; and


WHEREAS, the Yukon-Kuskokwim Coastal Resource Service Area has begun Coastal Zone Planning;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Bethel directs the City Administration and Planning Commission to begin as soon as practical, the Coastal Zone Management Planning Process.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Bethel requests financial assistance from the State of Alaska to develop a Coastal Zone Management Plan and authorizes the City Administration to receive and administer these funds.
