RESOLUTION NO. 279

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO CARRY OUT ALL FUNCTIONS NECESSARY IN DESIGNING AND CONSTRUCTING A SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL.

WHEREAS, within the Yukon-Kuskokwim Region and the City of Bethel there is a large number of elderly individuals who would benefit from expanded health and social services; and

WHEREAS, the existing Senior Center facilities are not adequate to meet the existing and future demand for services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has been awarded 1.5 million dollars with which to construct a new Senior Citizen Center;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the Senior Citizen project be pursued in such a way as to provide for construction of the Center this summer if possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as councils authorized representative in accepting and implementing the grant award including design and construction of the facility.
