

THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF BETHEL, ALASKA

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3

WHEREAS, the Alaska National Guard has requested permission from the Village Council of Bethel to build an Armory, and

WHEREAS, the site best suited for the buildings and ground includes Lots 7 through 17 of Block 7, which is designated as a Municipal Reserve on this official townsite plat, U.S. Survey 3230 A. and B., and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Reserve has been designated for use of the Village of Bethel for such public purposes as its citizens desire: and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Bethel were advised by public notice on October 30, 1956, to express objections to the cited proposed use of this part of the Municipal Reserve: and

WHEREAS, no objections from the residents were received during the 30 day period, nor to date, now therefore be it resolved by the President and members of the Council of the Village of Bethel, Alaska, as follows:

1. That the Alaska National Guard be, and they hereby are requested not to reappportion or sub-lease to any other agency or firm any portion of subject lots.
2. The land and improvements thereon will be used for Armory purposes only.
3. In the event that later on, it is decided that all of this ground is not needed, that portion will be turned back to the village.

NOW THEREFORE, be it understood that the Village Council for Bethel does hereby give permission to the Alaska National Guard to enter and utilize for an Armory construction and maintainance purposes Lots 7 through 17 of Block 7, Bethel Townsite, designated as Municipal Reserve on official townsite plat, U.S. Survey 3230 A. and B.

Passed and adopted by the members of the Bethel Village Council by a vote of 4 ayes and 0 nays.
