

RESOLUTION # 31

WHEREAS, two-hundred and seventy-three of five-hundred and twenty-four qualified voters voted for a non-profit liquor store for community use to be allowed in the City of Bethel, and

WHEREAS, THE City and its people are concerned with the proper method with which this store will be set up,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY the City Council of the City of Bethel:

That the City of Bethel will not entertain any application for a liquor license in the City of Bethel, unless that application specifies that the liquor store will be operated by 1 non-profit corporation for community use only.


AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel


