

RESOLUTION 34

APPROVING REQUEST FOR FINANCIAL
ASSISTANCE TO PLAN AND DEVELOP
A COMPREHENSIVE CITY DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel desires to undertake a comprehensive program to revitalize large blighted areas, to improve living conditions for the people who live in such areas; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to make grants to, and contract with, City Demonstration Agencies to pay 80% of the costs of planning and developing such city demonstration programs:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, that approval is hereby granted:

1. for the submission of a request for financial assistance for the planning and development of a comprehensive city demonstration program; and
2. for the provision of any information or documentation concerning the preparation and content of such program as may be required by the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and
3. for the representation by Michael Rowan, City Administrator, as the authorized representative empowered to act on behalf of the City of Bethel, Alaska, in connection with all matters pertaining to the request for financial assistance.
