A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, providing for the submission to the qualified voters of the city at a special election to be held therein on 1968, of a proposition of whether or not the city should issue its revenue bonds in the 130,000 principal amount of not to exceed \$105,000 for the purpose of providing part of the funds necessary to acquire, construct and equip a multi-purpose community building.

whereas, it is deemed necessary and advisable that the City of Bethel, Alaska (hereinafter called the "City"), acquire, construct and equip a multi-purpose community building, and, to provide funds to pay part of the cost thereof, that the City issue its revenue 130,000 (00).

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Alaska provide that the question of whether or not such bonds may be issued for such purposes must be submitted to the qualified voters of the City for their ratification or rejection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby found and declared that the public health, welfare, safety and convenience require the City to carry out the plans hereinafter provided.

Section 2. The City shall acquire, construct and equip a multi-purpose community building, and shall acquire all property and property rights necessary for such purpose, to be used for job training facilities, adult education facilities, recreation facilities, city offices and additional municipal purposes.

The estimated cost of the acquisition, construction and installation of such additions, improvements and extensions and the acquisition of such property rights is hereby declared to be, 1506,/cf.co 130,000 as near as may be, the sum of \$105,000, of which \$105,000 shall be paid out of the proceeds of sale of the revenue bonds hereinafter provided

for, and the balance of which shall be paid out of an anticipated grant from the United States of America.

Section 3. The above-mentioned bonds shall be sold at such time or times as found to be necessary and as permitted by law, shall bear interest at a rate of not to exceed 6% per annum, and shall mature in such amounts and at such times within twenty years from date of issue as the City Council may hereafter determine. The prinicpal of and interest on such bonds shall be payable out of all charges, rentals, or other income derived by the City from the operation and ownership of the above described community building, including income derived from leases of those portions of said building not immediately required for use by the city. The exact date, form, terms, maturities and covenants of said bonds shall be as hereafter fixed by ordinance of the City Council.

Section 4. The proposition of whether or not the City shall issue said bonds for the purposes above described shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the City for their ratification or rejection at a special election to be held within the City on the land of the City on the city of the c

Shall the City of Bethell, Alaska, issue its revenue 130,000 in the principal sum of not to arrange 220 bonds in the principal sum of not to exceed \$105,000, for the purpose of providing part of the funds necessary to acquire, construct and equip a multi-purpose community building for the city, and to acquire all property and property rights necessary for such purpose, said bonds to bear interest at a rate of not to exceed 6% per annum, to mature within twenty years from date of issue, to be paid, both principal and interest, out of revenues derived from all charges, rentals and other income derived by the city from the operation and ownership of said community building, all as more specifically provided in Resolution No. of the City Council.

There shall be one voting precinct for such special election, the boundaries of which are identical with the boundaries of the City of Bethel.

The polling place for such special election shall be the City Library.

The polls at such polling place will be open from 8:00 o'clock A.M. to 8:00 P.M.

Any person is qualified to vote who:

- a. Is a citizen of the United States;
- b. Is at least nineteen years of age;
- c. Has been a resident of the State of Alaska for at least one year immediately preceding the election;
- d. Has been a resident of the City of Bethelgat least thirty days immediately preceding the election; and
- e. Is able to speak or read the English language unless prevented by physical disability or who voted in the general election of November 4, 1924.
