

RESOLUTION NO. 5
OF THE FOURTH CLASS CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of August, 1959, the city of Bethel entered into a contract and agreement with the Northern Commercial Company of Bethel, Alaska for the delivery of electric power for street lights to all street lights authorized or installed by the City of Bethel and,

WHEREAS, said agreement provides that the Northern Commercial Company furnish the electrical power at the rate of \$2.50 per street light per month provided the capacity of the light bulbs used does not exceed 85 watts and

WHEREAS, said contract further stipulates that the Northern Commercial Company grants permission to the City of Bethel to install street lights on the power poles owned by said company but at no time shall the Northern Commercial Company be obliged to place poles at locations desired or selected by the city. Should the city desire to erect street lights at points where no power poles now or hereafter exist, then the cost and responsibility for placing such poles and lights will fall on the city and


WHEREAS, said contract further provides that the Northern Commercial Company will not be responsible for the installation or maintenance of street lights under the contract and said contract will be reviewed during the month of August of each and every year hereafter by the City Council and the Northern Commercial Company as to affecting changes or cancellation of said contract.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and members of the Council of the Fourth Class City of Bethel, Alaska

as follows:

That the contract above mentioned and referred to is hereby ratified and confirmed.
