RESOLUTION EXPRESSING INTENT OF CITY OF BETHEL TO COOPERATE WITH THE UNITED STATES CORPS OF ENGINEERS IN NAVIGATION IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF BETHEL.

- whereas, the City of Bethel as a Fourth-Class City, under Alaska statutes, is so empowered, and
- WHEREAS, the Department of the Army, Corps of Engineers has studied and prepared proposed plans for small-boat harbor and access channel dredging improvements within the City of Bethel, and
- WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City of Bethel participate with

  the Corps of Engineers in planning, land acquisition, cost

  sharing and construction of the dredging project and smallboat harbor,

Now, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Bethel, that it is the intention of the City to cooperate with the Corps of Engineers to the fullest extent of its capabilities in the planning, land acquisition, cost sharing and construction of the Brown's Slough dredging project and small-boat harbor in the following respects:

- <u>a.</u> Provide, maintain, and operate, without cost to the United States, as needed for transient and local operators, adequate public access roads, parking areas and other needed public use shore facilities, open and available to all on equal terms.
- $\underline{b}$ . Provide, without cost to the United States, all necessary lands, easements, and rights-of-way required for construction and subsequent maintenance of the project including suitable spoil disposal areas

with any necessary retaining dikes, bulkheads, and embankments there-
for.
$\underline{\mathtt{c}}_{ \cdot  }$ Hold and save the United States free from damages that may
result from construction and maintenance of the project.
$\underline{d}_{ullet}$ Accomplish, without cost to the United States, alterations
and relocations as required in sewer, water supply, drainage, and other
utility facilities.
e Assume full responsibility for all project costs in excess
of the Federal cost limitation of \$500,000.
