

RESOLUTION No. 6

WHEREAS the City of Bethel does not own any lands to be used for recreational purposes, or public purposes,

WHEREAS the Municipal Reserve as created in the townsire survey has been irrevocably turned over to various Departments of the State of Alaska before the City of Bethel was incorporated and organized,

WHEREAS the Alaska Department of Aveation has planned to eventually close the Airfield between the town of Bethel and the Public Health Hospital,

WHEREAS the lands occupied by the Alaska Department of Aviation will revert to the United States of America if ceased to be used for Airfield purposes as stipulated by Grant Deed of June 4, 1951,

WHEREAS the City of Bethel is desirous of obtaining lands for public and recreational purposes,

NOW BE IT RESOLVED THEREFORE that the City Council of Bethel make application to the United States Bureau of Land Management to set aside and grant to the City of Bethel those lands granted to the Territory of Alaska by Grant Deed of June 4, 1951, in the event the grounds would cease to be occupied by the State Department of Aviation for airfield purposes.
