RESOLUTION 95 OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Police Department does not have sufficient trained personnel to handle major disasters or calamities; and

WHEREAS, personnel employed by the Bethel City Police Department are not sufficient in number to provide proper coverage and protection for the City of Bethel during routine flu epidemics or other illnesses or accidents that might occur to members of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, there is routine need for more trained law enforcement personnel at routine fires, airplane crashes, major traffic accidents; and

WHEREAS, there is a need within the community for private employment of trained law enforcement personnel for security purposes such as security guards at P.H.S. and security guards for some local business establishments, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the Chief of Police shall have the power to provide a reserve force of Police-man who shall be qualified citizens of the community who shall be trained as prescribed by the Chief of Police and will be a voluntary reserve force and may as the need arises be employed on a parttime basis by the Chief of Police to augment the police force in time of need.
